

Getting started with the POSCA pens

#1

The liquid ink inside the pens are paint and glue. Try not to get this on your clothes or surfaces - so roll those sleeves up and put down some scrap paper before starting

#2

Shake the pens **GENTLY** to mix the paint and glue, but only with the lid on

#3

The pen may be brand new so the nib will look white. To get the paint flowing, use a scrap piece of paper and press down gently on the nib (known as 'dabbing'), but not too much or too hard or the paint will leak and you will end up with a puddle on your artwork (known as 'flooding')

#4

If you use two colours close together, let the first colour dry first before using the second, so the colours don't 'bleed' into each other

#5

You can easily clean the nibs of the pen with a wet wipe, if they become dirty
